Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Residents of Hopkinton, Holliston, Ashland, Milford, Westborough, Upton, Northborough or Southborough.

- Citizen, national or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Current senior high school student in Massachusetts who will enroll as a student in a two- or four-year U.S. accredited college or university, or other certificate program for higher learning, in the fall of 2022.

2. A **300 word (or less) essay response, typed and double-spaced.**
